


Using PsycINFO via Cambridge Scientific Abstracts

PsycINFO provides access to international literature in psychology, cognitive sciences, and related disciplines, including journal articles, book chapters, and dissertations. UCSD students, faculty, and staff can use PsycINFO throughout campus, and off campus through the Proxy Server: <http://scilib.ucsd.edu/bml/services/access.htm>

Quick Search



Search

1. Enter a phrase or keyword(s), e.g., **panic disorder**
2. Choose which part of the record to search, i.e., “as keyword(s)”, “in title”, “as author”, “in journal name”, and “anywhere”. **NOTE: a keyword search is recommended for subject searching**
3. Select the appropriate search type, i.e., “exact phrase”, “any of the words” (Boolean OR), or “All of the words” (Boolean AND)
4. Set the publication date range
5. Choose whether you want to have the results displayed by date of publication or relevancy
6. Select how the records will be displayed: citation, citation and abstract, or full record
