Edna Watson Bailey Photographs, 1905-1940

Physical Description: 106 black and white photographs (1/2 manuscript box)

Description: The accession consists of black and white original photographic prints varying in size from 2 ½ X 2 ¾ to 8X10 and dated between 1900 and 1940. These photographs were collected by Edna Watson, a graduate student and later the literary executor of William E. Ritter, founder and first director of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography. The photos include photographs of individuals including Watson and members of her family, Ritter, Manuel Cabral and other La Jolla colleagues. There are photographs of Enewah, the women students' residence at the University of California, Berkeley and of women graduates lined up for an undated commencement. The accession includes images of events, including the 1906 wreck of R/V LOMA at Point Loma in San Diego. The prints included images of La Jolla, Scripps' second location at La Jolla Cove ("the little green laboratory"), and the George H. Scripps Memorial Marine Biological Laboratory building on the Scripps campus.
