Description

The accession includes seven 16mm films and 343 35mm slides taken or acquired by Neil Marshall during the years he worked as a geologist at Scripps Institution of Oceanography in Francis P. Shepard's group. The films are not fully identified. One is labeled "Scripps Submarine canyon 1956 or 1957, F. P. Shepard Submarine Canyon." Another is labeled, "Moriarty and Beal 1952-1953 Squid in Canyon, Cabo san Lucas." Another appears to be a film shot by Sam Raymond of the 1966 maiden voyage of R/V Thomas Washington in the Bahamas. The 35mm slides include images documenting expeditions, oceanographic instrumentation and people. The slides include images of Caramarsel Expedition and other expeditions lead by Francis Shepard. The slides include many images relevant to plate tectonics, including cartoons and humorous images. Films and slides taken by Marshall while UC employee.
