Description: The accession consists of papers documenting campus theatrical evenings at Scripps Institution of Oceanography, UCSD. The accession includes a script of Flip III and the music for Alma Pater, performed in 1962. It includes the Jollywood Revues for 1986, 1988, 1991, and 2003. The 2003 performance celebrated the centennial of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography and included portions of Endless Holiday, an expedition spoof by John Knauss. The Jollywood Revue is an annual fundraising dinner and variety show organized by Oceanids, the UCSD Women's organization to benefit the scholarship fund. Constance Mullin organized and directed the "Jollywoods" for Oceanids and generated these files. The Revue typically included original music, dance, poetry and skits by university faculty and staff focused on the comical aspects of academic life. The files include programs, music, scripts, event photographs, budgets and other material.

Mary Ritter, wife of the first director of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography mentions in her diaries that plays were read and performed in the old Community House on the campus of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography during the early decades of the twentieth century. Scripps faculty wives including Ellen Revelle organized a playreaders group, which became part of Oceanids when it was founded in 1952. This group had a reading at the Revelle residence of the expedition farce Endless Holiday written by John Knauss in 1952. This was followed by a number of other original comic plays, parodies sung to Gilbert and Sullivan tunes, monologues and events, including the Flip I, II, and III shows in the early 1960s written by Madeline Miller and directed by Frederick W. Bush. One or more of these Flip shows included the famous "Flip Flop" dance performed by Thea Schultze and Nan Limbaugh. The Jollywood Revue added to this tradition, and sometimes reprised popular performances.
