PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: two open reel audio recordings; digital files made from original audio

DESCRIPTION: This accession consists of two reels of audio tape recordings of The Oceans 1968 – A New World, a symposium on oceanography commemorating the centennial anniversary of the founding of the University of California in 1868. The symposium, presented by the Scripps Institution of Oceanography, was held February 1 and 2, 1968 at Sherwood Hall in La Jolla, California. Several scientists from SIO and other institutions took part, giving lectures on major areas of marine research. The lectures were "designed for those who are nonspecialists," according to William Nierenberg.

Lectures for Thursday, February 1 are on Reel 1; morning session on side 1, afternoon session on side 2. Lectures for Friday, February 2 are on Reel 2; morning session on side 1 and afternoon session on side 2. The first talk on Reel 2, side 2 (Bascom) is cut after 5 minutes due to a recorder malfunction; the tape continues with the second talk.
