Helen Hill Raitt Papers, 1850 – 1985

Physical Description: 18 mss, 2 shoe boxes

Arrangement: Accessions 92-27 and 95-5 were arranged into series consisting of Correspondence, Manuscripts, and Subject Files. Files relating to Baja California, Tonga, Tofua Press, or to the Capricorn Expedition were placed into their own series. The typescripts were added to the Manuscripts series and R. Renee Heyum's files were added to the Tofua Press series. Photographs, negatives, and illustrations, including those from the typescripts, were added to the Photographs series. Newspaper clippings were added to the Subject Files. Accession 95-5 contained files belonging to both Russell Raitt and Helen Raitt. These were separated and added to 92-27 or 82-59 based largely on the folder contents or on the handwriting. Raitt family correspondence and files concerning the Raitt's home were added to the Helen Raitt Papers (92-27). Folders from MSS 146 were added to the Tonga, Tofua Press, and Photographs series.

Folder titles were transcribed onto folders, and additional information may have been added for clarification or consistency. Documents within folders have been arranged chronologically. Staples and other metal fasteners were removed. Newspaper clippings and other acidic papers were photocopied onto acid-free paper, and the originals discarded. Published items were removed and a separation sheet citing them placed in the front of the folder. Legal-sized items are filed at the end of the collection; oversized items are located in the map case; and restricted items have been placed in FC44. They are marked with an L, O, or R, respectively, in the folder list.

The Helen Hill Raitt Papers are arranged in the following series: Correspondence; Baja California; Capricorn Expedition; Manuscripts; Subject Files; Tonga; Tofua Press; Photographs and Illustrations; Audiotapes

Description: The Helen Raitt Papers provide substantial information concerning the Capricorn Expedition, Tofua Press, the Baja California Collection, and Helen Raitt's published manuscripts. The majority of her papers fall between the dates 1952 and 1976. There is some correspondence between Helen and Russell Raitt and their children, but there is very little information concerning her family or herself before 1936. Additional correspondence for the years 1946-1969, including correspondence and interview notes for *Scripps Institution of Oceanography: First Fifty Years* can be found in the SIO Biographical Files.

**CORRESPONDENCE SERIES 1936 – 1976:** The Correspondence Series includes Helen Raitt's incoming and outgoing correspondence from 1936 to 1976, arranged alphabetically by folder title. Correspondents include her family, publishers, Tofua Press staff, and friends in Tonga and Mexico. There is correspondence concerning her travel to Tonga, Hawaii, Japan, Mexico, and on the Capricorn Expedition. Tofua Press correspondents include Donna Gerstle, Clare Huston, and Emelita Johnston; Tongans include Pat Matheson, Tupou Poesi Fanua, and Princess Salote and King Taufa'ahau Tupou IV, or their secretaries. Correspondence has been arranged alphabetically by correspondent

**BAJA CALIFORNIA SERIES 1939 – 1975:** The Baja California series contains Helen Raitt's subject files regarding travel, culture, history, organizations, and education in Baja California, Mexico. This series is arranged alphabetically by folder title. The largest subseries is the Baja California Collection of the UCSD Library. Helen Raitt was the acquisitions chairman for the Friends of the Library Baja California Committee, and her files document the formation of the Baja California Collection, acquisitions to the collection, bibliographies on Baja California, and the role of the Friends of the Library in building the collection. Another subseries is the Asociación Cultural de las Californias, which contains Helen Raitt's files on the formation of the association and the many symposia on Baja California which it hosted. Her files also document the involvement of SIO with the Escuela Superior de Ciencias Marinas through the People to People project. There are also files of newspaper clippings regarding Baja California from 1965 to 1972, including a file of clippings about SIO geologist Robert F. Dill's travel in Baja California in 1968. Correspondence on Baja California can be found in the Correspondence series.

**CAPRICORN EXPEDITION SERIES 1952 – 1954:** The Capricorn Expedition series contains notes and other files kept by Helen Raitt during the 1952-1953 Capricorn Expedition to Fiji, Tonga, the Samoas, Tahiti, and the Marquesas islands aboard research vessels *Horizon* and *Spencer F. Baird*. Russell Raitt was senior geophysicist on the expedition, which was studying, among other things, the Tonga Trench and the sea floor of the Pacific. Helen Raitt had flown to Suva, Fiji, to meet her husband during the Christmas holidays and was invited by Roger Revelle to join the expedition. Helen Raitt kept several handwritten notebooks as well as typed notes during the expedition. She kept travel information for each of the islands visited, and typed reports, scientific logs, and plans of the day aboard the *Spencer F. Baird*. There is also an essay by Roger Revelle on Polynesia. This series is arranged alphabetically by folder title. Correspondence from the expedition can be found in the Correspondence series; photographs are located in the Photographs and Illustrations series.

**MANUSCRIPTS SERIES 1937 – 1971:** The Manuscripts series contains notes, drafts, and typescripts for many of Helen Raitt's published and unpublished manuscripts, arranged alphabetically by manuscript title. "Bargains in Adventure" is a travel article on Mexico written by Helen Raitt in 1937. "The Campus of 5,000 Trees" is an undated essay about the UCSD campus. "Give Us Room" is the transcript of a radio talk on the history of SIO given by Helen Raitt in 1961-1962. "Problems of the Underwater Swimmer in the South Pacific" was a report written by Helen Raitt for the National Research Council Panel on Underwater Swimmers in 1953. The report includes her notes and bibliographies regarding ocean swimming and diving in

the South Pacific. The typescript for *Scripps Institution of Oceanography: First Fifty Years*, which Helen Raitt co-wrote with Beatrice Moulton, is included, as are two typescripts for *Uncle This is William*, the story of the Capricorn Expedition, which was later published as *Exploring the Deep Pacific*. The early drafts of *Uncle This is William* contain chapters about the Capricorn Expedition in Fiji and Tonga that were not included in the published edition. Draft K contains comments by the editor, Roger Revelle, and SIO Public Relations director Lon Manar

**SUBJECT FILES SERIES 1906 – 1976:** The Subject Files series is arranged alphabetically and contains Helen Raitt's files on people, organizations, travel, education, and literature. Her calendars are included in this series, as are her scrapbooks, which contain mostly newspaper clippings and correspondence. The contents of the scrapbooks were not affixed to the scrapbooks, so they have been arranged chronologically and placed in acid-free folders. Helen Raitt kept many files of newspaper clippings, including the American Red Cross Arts and Crafts Skills Corps, her son, Senator W. Craig Biddle, San Diego history and real estate, and her own published works. Her travel files, excluding Baja California, Capricorn Expedition, and Tonga, are also in this series. There is a file on the Scripps Estates Associates, and photocopies of the design and construction files of the Raitts' home.

**TONGA SERIES 1850 – 1975:** The Tonga series contains Helen Raitt's files on Tongan and South Pacific history, literature, and travel. The series contains files from her trip to Tonga in 1973 and 1974, and a list of books that she mailed to Tonga in 1973. There are also transcripts of works by Dumont d'Urville and George Vason, and notes and bibliographies on Tongan literature. The series is arranged alphabetically by folder title.

**TOFUA PRESS SERIES 1970 – 1985:** The Tofua Press series contains notes, reviews, flyers, clippings, and other information regarding Tofua Press and its publications, particularly *We Three Came West* and *Tonga Pictorial*. The file "Helen Raitt and Tofua Press" donated by R. Renee Heyum has been added to this series. The series has been arranged alphabetically by folder title. Correspondence between Helen Raitt and Tofua Press staff is located in the Correspondence series.

**PHOTOGRAPHS and ILLUSTRATIONS 1869 – 1976:** The Photographs and Illustrations series contains photographs of Helen Raitt's family and friends, SIO, Tonga, Tofua Press, and illustrations from her published works. The series contains photographs of Roger and Ellen Revelle, Myrtle Johnson and Edna Watson Bailey, Scripps Estates Associates, and the Thomas Wayland Vaughan Aquarium-Museum dedication. Many of the photographs of Tonga were taken by Helen Raitt's grandson, Christopher Gist and document the people and culture of Tonga in the 1970s. Contact sheets, negatives, and a log are included for the Tonga photographs. This series also includes the illustrations that were published with *Exploring the Deep Pacific (Uncle This is William)*, and *Scripps Institution of Oceanography: First Fifty Years*, which provide many photographs of the Capricorn Expedition in 1952-1953 and of SIO from 1904 to 1965. This series is arranged alphabetically by folder title.

**AUDIOTAPES 1971 – 1972:** The Audiotapes series contains Helen Raitt's audiocassette recordings of music, lectures, and conversations with people she met in Tonga. Most are not

dated, but are believed to date from her 1971-1972 trip to Tonga. The tapes are arranged alphabetically by title.

**RESTRICTIONS:** One document containing social security numbers has been restricted according to University policy. The restricted document was removed from the original folder and placed in FC44; a separation sheet identifying the item was placed in the original folder. The document has been restricted fifty years from the date of creation. The folder is identified with an “R” in the folder list.

**PROVENANCE:** While working as archivist for SIO, Helen Raitt was believed to have donated two typescripts of *Exploring the Deep Pacific* and one of *Scripps Institution of Oceanography: First Fifty Years*. These were later found in the SIO Archives and in UCSD Special Collections, and were accessioned as 82-18 and 85-18. R. Renee Heyum, curator of the Hawaiian and Pacific Collection of the University of Hawaii Library, donated two folders of correspondence and other materials about Tofua Press in 1987. These folders were titled "Helen Raitt and Tofua Press" and accessioned as 88-10. Most of Helen Raitt's papers (accession 92-27) were donated by her husband, Russell Raitt, on September 14, 1992. Additional papers (accession 95-5) were found in the Raitt home after Dr. Raitt's death, mixed with his own papers. These were donated to the SIO Archives on August 18, 1995, by a deed of gift signed by the Raitts' four children: W. Craig Biddle, Charles J. Biddle, Martha Harrison, and Alison Gist. Helen Raitt's papers were added to this collection; Russell Raitt's papers were added to 82-59. The Raitts' house was later purchased by Alan Jaffe, who loaned the blueprints and files regarding the design and construction of the house to SIO Archives for photocopying in 1997. Additional photographs, negatives, and documents regarding Tonga and Tofua Press (MSS 146) were transferred from UCSD Special Collections on October 8, 1997 and were added to this collection.
